**Chamber Next meeting** - will be on Tuesday 19th March 2019, 5.30pm for 6pm start at Westbourne House. The meeting will include the AGM where new officers are elected and the Chamber accounts for the year will be presented.

Our new office has a 'shop front' and we look forward to welcoming new and existing clients during 2019 and beyond".

The new office is modern but retains the classic Grade II listed features of a stone property, including beams in the client meeting space on the first floor. Tom explained "We wanted to create a welcoming and comfortable environment for clients to come and discuss their goals and aspirations for the future. Building financial plans that deliver on those goals with long term financial security is something we are excited to continue in our new home".

**Crossgate Garage and Woods Forge Garage** – these 2 long standing car repair workshops have merged premises so both now occupy Crossgate Garage behind the Rose and Crown, accessed via Crossgate.

**Employing Staff** – two big changes will affect wages from 1st April 2019

- on 1st April 2019 the minimum wage will increase from £7.83 to £8.21 for those aged 25 or above, from £7.38 to £7.70 for 21-24 year olds, from £5.90 to £6.15 for 18-20 year olds, from £4.20 to £4.35 for under 18s and from £3.70 to £3.90 for apprentices.
- on 1st April 2019 minimum payments into auto enrolment pension will also increase from 2 to 3% for the employers contribution and from 3 to 5% for the staff contribution meaning an overall increase in 3% going into pension pots.

**GPG** Accounts – the Granville Mount based accountant is expanding into a larger neighbouring premises.

**Graffiti Clean Up** – The Christmas period saw an unfortunate spate of over 70 graffiti attacks on private property. Whilst West Yorkshire Police have successfully apprehended the culprit Otley in Bloom and Otley Chamber worked together to rally the troops on Sunday 8th January with a successful clean up of the offending artwork. Around 25 people turned up and donated over 40 hours of time. Many residents came, but here is a shout out to the businesses who were represented; Patisserie Viennoise, Doris Dent Estates, Shake Bar, Courtyard Planters, The Junction Inn, Cranberry, Print Crew and three PCSO's also attended.



**Inflation** - Britain's Consumer Price Index inflation indicator, continues to drop month on month and stood at 2.2% in November 2018, it was 3.1% at the same time last year.

Licencing application for 13 Orchard Gate – Rumagin Spirits Ltd have filed an application for a drinks license on the former Otley Health and Martial Arts/Doris Dent Estates premises for alcohol sales form 11am -7pm 6 days per week.

Otley Coffee Festival – in spring 2020 Otley Parish Church will play host to an inaugural Coffee Festival. The festivals are 'all about the journey from bean to cup', where you can enjoy finding out more about coffee and associated products, whatever your level of expertise. Putting on a festival is expensive and tricky. It requires money and people. If you can help, let Richard know at richard@theyorkshirewordwright.co.uk. We need the following help already:



- Another coffee shop proprietor to join the board of the festival delivery company. This will involve a maximum time commitment of two to three hours a month.
- Sponsors to help with the costs. Various sponsor packages are available from £50 to £500.

More details will be released as they become available.

Rachel's Made to Measure – the curtain, blind and cushion maker has moved from Chevin Mill, Leeds Road to new premises at 31 Cross Green where workshops for children and parents have been launched this year.

# **Training Opportunities for businesses -**

• Chamber member White Rose Training offered 3 free sessions of CPR and defibrillator training in January which means that alongside the 19 public access defibrillators there are another 20+ people who have experienced how to use them. Ken Creek, owner of White Rose training and Otley's lead community responder showed how the defibrillators worked and took away any fear of the unknown that might be had. Once deployed and switched on they talk to you and tell you want to do, it is impossible to do any harm as the machine assesses the patient and decides whether a shock is needed. The machines in Otley have been deployed (this means that someone has called 999 and been given the code to access the machines) many times, with at least one life saved, but there could be more as the recording is not totally accurate.

They are currently using the upper floors but have ownership of the whole building, and improved the look of the building before Christmas with a window mural by Jenny Tribillion. WRM Ltd are involved in sustainability, waste and recycling management, resource and energy management.

Wharfebank Mills - Pegholme top floor refurbishment completed

Two years after Wharfebank Mills, Otley, changed hands, the new owners continue to fulfil their promise to develop this picturesque and prominent estate, breathing new life into the former textile mill to make it fit for purpose in the 21st century.

This new phase of development has involved renovating the top floor of Pegholme Mill, the largest building on site, to create  $4 \times \text{circa} 410 \text{ ft2}$  units and  $1 \times \text{circa} 580 \text{ ft2}$  unit (two of which were let before practical completion), to meet demand from local businesses.

These new office spaces offer light, contemporary work environments while still retaining some of the old features, as a nod to the building's historical past. A communal break out area has also been installed with modern shared kitchen facilities allowing occupiers to enjoy a lunch hour away from their desk.

Further activity includes; the top corridor receiving the same branding as the ground and first floor, and the historic goods lift has been converted to a fully functioning passenger lift. This will make the middle and top floors accessible to all occupants and visitors.

Of course, this could not be achieved without the patience and understanding of our existing tenants, on the floors below, as we continue to improve Wharfebank Mills and make it a place that tenants and staff will enjoy working in for years to come. Many thanks to them for their support.

The photographs below show how quickly the offices spaces have been transformed ready for new occupants.
